



Residential Security and Justice Governance and Reform

Logistical Guidance

UN TRAINING SCHOOL, CURRAGH CAMP, CO KILDARE, Ireland

29 November – 3 December 2021

Course description

The course aims to provide participants with the knowledge and practical tools on security sector governance and reform (SSG/R) and justice. It touches upon the holistic nature of SSG/R and covers dimensions related to human security, access to justice and good governance with a focus on both people-centered and state-centered security and justice in various development contexts.

This in-person program will be held in person on the grounds of the United Nations Training School Ireland (UNTSI). For further information on the learning methodology, the curriculum, and the agenda, please see the Course Description.

Course structure and Logistics

The SJGR course includes five full days of sessions, spread across 8h each day with numerous breaks and interactive group sessions. The course will be complemented with social activities for participant cohesion, such as a formal end-of-course dinner. The course commences on 29 November at 08.30 AM and concludes on 3 December at 12.00 PM.

International Travel

- International Travel to and from Ireland is a national / individual responsibility

Arrival in Ireland

- International participants will be greeted at **Dublin airport** by a member of UNTSI staff, from where they will transfer to the UNTSI military accommodation or their hotel. Course registration will be held in UNTSI at **0830 hrs on Monday 29 November 2021**. Arrival on **28 November** is a preferred for participants.

Departure

- The Course will end at 12.30hrs on Friday 3 December 2021. Please arrange flight times to home destinations with this time in mind. Military transport will return students to Dublin airport.



Accommodation

- Military accommodation is available for all participants free of charge for the entirety of the course duration. This is a modest accommodation with shared bathroom facilities on the grounds of the military base.
- Alternative accommodation is available in the Keadeen Hotel in the nearby town of Newbridge. The cost per night in a single room is €99 (inc. breakfast) and the details of the hotel are available at www.keadeen.ie. Students choosing the latter will be transported to and from the hotel by military transport on a daily basis. The responsibility of booking is that of the individual participant.

Meals

- Participants choosing to stay on site will dine in the Military College Officers Mess at the following times:
 - a. Breakfast (if) 730 - 830 hrs
 - b. Lunch 1300 - 1345 hrs
 - c. Dinner (if) 1700 - 1800 hrs

End of Course Dinner

- The end of course dinner will be held on Thursday 2 December 2021 at 1900hrs.

Special Dietary Requirements

- Every effort will be made to cater for special dietary requirements if the necessary information is included on the Personal Details Form to be completed by chosen participants.

Costs in Summary

- The costs of the course are as follows:
- Tuition fees - No Charge
- International Travel - Financial responsibility of participant
- Military Lodging (no charge) **or/** Hotel Accommodation (€99 per night)
- Meals and Administration: ~~€175~~ (payment accepted in cash only) is payable by all students to cover daily meals, the end of course dinner, an 'Icebreaker' and other activities. This fee will be collected on joining the course on Monday 29 November 2021.

Location

UNTSI is located in the Defence Forces Training Centre, at the Curragh, 48 km South West of Dublin, just off the M7 motorway at Exit 12 (approx.1 hour from Dublin Airport).The nearby towns of Newbridge (2km) and Kildare (5km) are well served by bus and rail and Taxi services. There is a great selection of bars, cafes, restaurants as well as supermarkets and shopping arcades.
