





# INFORMATION ABOUT CONDITIONS AND COSTS OF PARTICIPATION

# ESDC CORE COURSE ON SECURITY SECTOR REFORM (SSR) 3-10 OCTOBER 2014, STADTSCHLAINING/AUSTRIA

## 1. Conditions of Participation

Potential participants are expected to have expertise in their respective areas of professional competence related to SSR and should currently be or plan to be <u>involved in planning</u>, <u>assessing</u>, <u>and/or implementing SSR activities</u>. Interested representatives from <u>the military</u>, the <u>police and the judiciary</u> are equally encouraged to apply, as well as representatives from <u>governmental bodies</u>, <u>international organizations</u>, <u>NGOs</u> and <u>other civil society actors</u> working in the field of SSR.

Since English will be the working language of the course, participants <u>must have a good command of English</u> to be able to engage in discussions and fully benefit from the training.

Since the course is designed in a modular structure, <u>participants who wish to arrive late or depart early cannot be accepted</u>. The intense format of the programme does not allow for any additional commitments during the course.

The ESDC requires all participants to complete selected IDL (Internet-Based Distance Learning) modules in the preparatory phase preceding the residential part of the course. The <u>timely completion of the IDL phase is a precondition for receiving a certificate at the end of the course in Stadtschlaining.</u>

#### 2. Selection of Participants

The organizers intend to select a highly diverse group of participants in terms of professional and organisational background, age and nationality, and with regard to gender balance. However, as only a limited number of 30 participants can be accepted, priority is given to applicants who best fulfil the conditions outlined above to ensure training at the highest level.

### 3. Costs of Participation

The support of the Austrian Ministry of Defence and Sports covers all course related expenses (such as participation fees, course materials, expert honoraria, facilities, etc.). Participants only need to cover their full board accommodation at the local Hotel and Conference Centre for the duration of the training as well as their travel expenses. Free collective transport between Vienna and the course venue will be provided by the ASPR. Furthermore, participants will be responsible for all beverages, laundry, telephone bills and other personal costs that might occur.

The total cost for 7 nights full-board accommodation (incl. coffee breaks) at Hotel Burg Schlaining amounts to € 780,- per participant. Information on the payment procedures will be sent out to participants in due course.
